The Catawba Indian Nation intends to award a unit price contract to construct approximately 930 ft of 8-inch PVC C900 DR 18 water main along the west side of Rivercrest Road. The project connects to the existing water main just North of the Rivercrest / Sturgis intersection then crosses under the road and travels southwest along Rivercrest Road. The alignment crosses Burgis Creek and runs parallel to the newly constructed bridge. The project is located on the Catawba Indian Reservation located in Rock Hill, South Carolina.

Work under this project consists of water main installation, earthwork grading, traffic control, and other miscellaneous items. The design and engineering have been completed.

The specifications provided by CIN Division of Environmental Services and included with the project plans shall be used throughout construction.

The period of performance for this project will be 180 days after a written Notice to Proceed. Included in the final construction contract will be a clause assessing the contractor \$750 per calendar day for failure to achieve substantial completion in the allotted time unless a time extension is granted by the Catawba Indian Nation.
